DAMAGE TO BUILDINGS

Misuse or damage to the buildings and common areas by attaching satellite dishes (except to the recepticles on each unit's roof), antennas, signs, lights or any other items without written permission of the Board. Holiday lights are an exception.

- 1. Causing damage or vandalism to the common areas lawns, roofs, gutters, plumbing, parking areas, sidewalks, sprinkler systems, flowers, trees, shrubs, fences, roadways, lights and light posts, road signs, sidewalks, etc.
- 2. Climbing on fences.

GENERAL USE OF COMMON AND LIMITED COMMON AREAS

- 1. Leaving personal items in the common areas including bicycles, scooters, toys, personal equipment and clothing. Items will be picked up and stored by a Board member for one week then discarded.
- 2. Not keeping your patio clean and neat in appearance for stored items.

RULES REGARDING NUISANCE - NOISE AND DISTURBANCES

- 1. Creating any nuisance (loud music, TV, loud partying, yelling, screaming, swearing, or heavy smoking) within your unit, patios or common areas, that is heard or smelled by others and is offensive to the senses, an obstruction to the free use of property and disruptive to the comfortable enjoyment and lifestyle of other residents.
- 2. Continuing with loud partying, TV, yelling, screaming, swearing or crowd noise after being asked to quiet down and after 10:00 PM when your neighbors are being disturbed.

RESTRICTIONS ON OPERATING A BUSINESS

- 1. Operating a business in a unit without a proper business license in violation of the municipal ordinances, the CC&Rs, and written permission of the Board.
- 2. Operating a business in a unit that necessitates heavy traffic from outsiders to enter your premises to conduct said business.

The cumulative fine for continuing violation may not exceed \$500 per month. These rules and fines are subject to review by the Board.
