#### Notes to the Financials

To prevent further damage, the HOA Board made the decision to use capital reserve funds for roof repair on 29 units for the total of \$17,400. Also, several trees were cut down due to wind and beaver damage, which resulted in additional expenses. Capital reserve funds were used for Quarter 4 rather than being sent to reserve to cover these one-off projects.

## **PET OWNERS**

#### Owners of Pets

Each month, the Canyon Woods HOA collects dues to assist with the costs of projects, upkeep of the complex, paying bills, addressing unforeseen expenses, etc. These dues, however, do not address owners of pets NOT CONFINED TO THE HOME.

If you own a pet, or pets, that must go outside regularly, you must pay an additional \$10 per pet (up to two pets) per month along with your HOA dues.

Residents not paying additional pet dues will receive a warning.

Please update your monthly payment to include the additional \$10 per pet or contact Utah Management to add the fee.
