3. During its existence, Stonegate has allowed unit owners to lease their units to tenants without first consulting the owners' association.	
4. A number of the unit owners have leased their units to tenants.	

Some of these tenants have caused problems at Stonegate and have detracted

- from the peace and enjoyment of other residents of the condominium. Many of the unit owners are also concerned that the value of their units will be adversely affected if Stonegate becomes a condominium of rental units with the attendant high
- The unit owners have decided to take steps to limit the number of rental units at the condominium in order to reduce the disruption caused by unruly tenants and to preserve the property values of their units.

Therefore, the owners of the units at Stonegate do hereby adopt the following amendment to the Declaration.

SECTION ONE

There is hereby added a new paragraph to Article XV of the Declaration, which shall read as follows:

At no time may more than sixteen percent (16%) of the units be leased to persons who are not owners of a unit at the project, provided that, upon a majority vote of the management committee, this limit may be raised if compelling circumstances exist for the raising of the limit, If the Management Committee raises the limit on leasing above sixteen percent (16%), it shall review the limit at least once every six months and shall lower the limit back to sixteen percent (16%) as soon as the compelling circumstances which led the Management Committee to raise. the limit are resolved.
