It is our goal to maintain an attractive and uniform appearance throughout the HOA community. Please read through the items listed below if you would like to apply to install a fence on HOA common property.

- 1. The fence must be uniform throughout the complex. (i.e. tan vinyl, six feet in height)
- 2. The fence must extend seven feet six inches from the home. This means the fence is 7' 6" from outside post to outside post.
- 3. The fence must be installed by a licensed and insured contractor.
- 4. The fence must be installed in comparison with the owner's home property lines.
- 5. It is the owner's responsibility to repair and maintain the fence.
- 6. If the fence causes dry spots by blocking sprinklers, the owner must hire a licensed and insured contractor to adjust the sprinklers.
- 7. The owner installing the fence will need signatures of attached neighbors that it is okay to install a fence.
- 8. If the home is sold it is the owner's obligation to notify the new owner that they are responsible to maintain the fence.
